



NEW RICHMOND REPUBLIC
CONGRESS OF PEOPLE'S COUNCILS

BE IT ENACTED by the elected delegates of the people's councils of the New Richmond Republic in Congress assembled during the second ordinary session thereof...

AN ACT

regarding the administration of the District of Fayette

This Act has been wholly superseded by the Second Basic Law. Original text:

1. *The District of Fayette shall be governed on the basis of consensus among all residents thereof without the necessity for a People's Council or a prerequisite of Party membership for engagement in local administration.*
2. *The residents of the District of Fayette shall elect their delegate to the Congress of People's Councils from among themselves; however, in accordance with the Basic Law, any delegate must be a member of the Blair Mountain League.*

Enacted by the Congress of People's Councils and thereafter promulgated by the People's Commissioner of the Republic on this nineteenth day of February in the year two-thousand and twenty-two of the Common Era, and in the year of the Revolution the first.
